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what impact do revolutionary states have on the international community this important study focuses on this question showing major problems these states pose for the achievement of world order it also examines whether the revolutionary state adapts to international standards of acceptable patterns of behavior or the international society is forced to change as a result of the emergence of these revolutionary states the work also looks at the american french and russian revolutions as well as several post 1945 revolutionary states to find the relationship between the revolutionary states and the principal ordering devices of international society

this book looks at how the ideas of freedom property and order are expressed in modern social contract theories scets drawing on the theories of hobbes locke rousseau and rawls it studies how notions of freedom promulgated by these scets invariably legitimise and defend the private ownership of the means of production it argues that capitalism s impact on individual dependence and economic inequality still stems from this model ultimately working in favour of proprietors the author highlights the problematic nature of scets which work as ideological mechanisms put forward under the guise of formal equality and formal freedom by focusing on the historical and social context behind them from a methodological point of view the author presents a de ideologization of the contractarian issue and provides insight into the political layers within the discourse of individualism human nature and morality shaping the outer corners of contractarian theory an important intervention in the study of scets this volume will be of great interest to scholars and researchers of political and social theory sociology political history and political philosophy

in the past few decades the understanding of the relationship between nations has undergone a radical transformation the role of the traditional nation state is diminishing along with many of the traditional vocabularies which were once used to describe what has been called ever since jeremy bentham coined the phrase in 1780 international law the older boundaries between states are growing ever more fluid new

conceptions and new languages have emerged which are slowly coming to replace the image of a world of sovereign independent nation states which has dominated the study of international relations since the early nineteenth century this redefinition of the international arena demands a new understanding of classical and contemporary questions in international and legal theory it is the editors conviction that the best way to achieve this is by bridging the traditional divide between international legal theory intellectual history and legal and political history the aim of the series therefore is to provide a forum for historical studies from classical antiquity to the twenty first century that are theoretically informed and for philosophical work that is historically conscious in the hope that a new vision of the rapidly evolving international world its past and its possible future may emerge book jacket

wang gungwu is one of the most influential historians of his generation initially renowned for his pioneering work on the structure of power in early imperial china he is more widely known for expanding the horizons of chinese history to include the histories of the chinese and their descendents outside china it is probably no coincidence philip kuhn observes that the most comprehensive historian of the overseas chinese is the historian most firmly grounded in the history of china itself this book is a celebration of the life work and impact of professor wang gungwu over the past four decades it commemorates his contribution to the study of chinese history and the abiding influence he has exercised over later generations of historians

particularly in the asia pacific region the book begins with an historiographical survey by philip kuhn francis lee higgenson professor of history at harvard university of wang gungwu s enduring contribution to scholarship it concludes with an engaging oral history of professor wang s life career and research trajectory the intervening chapters explore many of the fields in which wang gungwu s influence has been felt over the years including questions of political authority national identity commercial life and the history of the diaspora from imperial times to the present day each of these chapters is authored by a former student of professor wang now working and teaching in hong kong southeast asia australasia taiwan and canada

is our grasping that which came to be and comprehending its becoming is only one form and expression of our understanding of the present and existing and this becoming and having come to be can be derived only by temporally conceiving and analysing the existing in order to understand it we must therefore center our attention on what may be called the structure and logic of social order
